Characteristics of the Residency Program:

Most of the time the residency training program will be carried out at the MG Veterinary Medical Center, which I own, at Av. Ricardo Balbín 3223, in the Coghlan neighborhood, in the Autonomous City of Buenos Aires, Argentine Republic.

The Coghlan neighborhood is close to different shopping centers, cafes, restaurants and cinemas, which can be accessed by walking or by bus, many of which have their stop a few meters from the office. Nearby there are also subway stops that lead to various areas of the city. Among them the center of the city stands out where you can access the Historic Center, theaters, cinemas and restaurants. The MG Veterinary Medical Center consists of a waiting room, three offices, in one the dermatological clinical cases are attended; in another the cytology stains are performed with subsequent

microscopic observation and in the third office the biopsies are performed on designated days.

The office is equipped:

- Wood Lamp
- Olympus CH binocular optical microscope
- Stain 15 (Diff Quick® tipe)
- Welch Allyn®Otoscope

Samples for clinical analysis, histopathology, cultures, are sent to different laboratories which allows us to work together maintaining a permanent dialogue.

I receive cases referred by other colleagues from the Autonomous City of Buenos Aires and from more remote areas such as Pilar, Escobar, Tigre, Lujan, among others.

The other site of the residency program will be carried out in the dermatological office UBA Faculty of Veterinary Sciences Hospital, where derived dermatological cases are diagnosed and treated; taking samples for cytology, biopsies, histopathological study and interpretation with the histopathologist; and otoscopy.

Within the same Hospital we hold monthly meetings where complex dermatological clinical cases are discussed, and different journals are presented. We also have the possibility of consulting with other colleagues from different specialties about concomitant pathologies that our patients may present.
